BREATHE LA Partners with Clean Power Alliance for Clean Energy Education

CPA partnership grant gives BREATHE LA the expanded opportunity to provide residents with sustainable and financial energy education

LOS ANGELES, CA., June 12, 2020 – BREATHE California of Los Angeles County (BREATHE LA) has recently partnered with Clean Power Alliance (CPA) to provide education about clean energy and lung health. The partnership will enable BREATHE LA to empower residents in disadvantaged communities across southern Los Angeles by helping them learn about the advantages of choosing clean energy options and the financial incentives available to those who qualify.

Aligned with CPA's goals and objectives, BREATHE LA will integrate clean energy messaging into their existing free Adult Lung Health educational workshop program among targeted populations in Los Angeles County. Breathe Easier and Achieve Energy Efficiency workshops will provide information about air quality and the environment as it relates to lung health, and will introduce clean energy options for residential consumers to lessen the load on the grid.

"The partnership between BREATHE LA and Clean Power Alliance allows us to effectively raise awareness about how cleaner energy consumption options can positively impact community health," says BREATHE LA's Director of Programs Kara Karibian. "We're continuing to bring sustainable options in favor of improved health to the communities that we serve by and raising awareness about the critical link between environmental health and chronic lung disease".

BREATHE LA and CPA will provide a high-impact, three-tiered strategy that will reach more than 5,000 households. BREATHE LA's Health Educators have designed a workshop curriculum with targeted messaging about the wide range of CPA's available resources and will deliver the education by hosting 7 workshops, either virtually or at community center sites, across Los Angeles County.

BREATHE LA will track customer feedback, number of attendees interested in enrolling in CPA's Power Response Program (e.g., smart thermostats) and number of attendees interested in enrolling in CPA's DAC-GT. BREATHE LA will provide CPA with a final report at the end of the one-year partnership period.
