



## **GUY SOO HOO, M.D.**

**BOARD MEMBER SINCE 1992R**

Guy W. Soo Hoo, M.D. is currently a member of the Board of Directors of Breathe Southern California and has served on several committees, including as the chair of the Board of Directors in its past iteration at the American Lung Association of Los Angeles County from 1997-98 and 2004-2005. He has also been president of the Trudeau Society of Los Angeles, first serving from 1994-1995, and from 2005 through 2021.

Dr. Soo Hoo has been a volunteer with the organization since 1992, also serving as chairman of the Research Committee at the state and local levels. He first became involved with the Lung Association after receiving a research grant to study non-invasive ventilation in patients with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD).

Dr. Soo Hoo, is currently the Director for the Medical Intensive Care Unit and chief of the Pulmonary, Critical Care and Sleep Section at West Los Angeles Healthcare Center of the Veterans Administration Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System and a Professor of Clinical Medicine at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA.

Dr. Soo Hoo attended George Washington University in Washington, D.C., and obtained his M.D. from the University of New Mexico's School of Medicine. He earned a Masters of Public Health degree from the UCLA School of Public Health.
